November was Mouth Cancer Action Month



Over the last year, 8,337 people in the UK were given the life-changing news that they have mouth cancer. This means that one person in the UK is diagnosed with mouth cancer every hour.

These numbers continue to rise while the disease claims more lives than cervical and testicular cancer combined. A lot of this is linked to the late diagnosis of the disease.

As a practice we have seen this increase in diagnosis first hand. Our clinical team regularly updates their knowledge on spotting mouth cancer early and the referral protocols to follow.

By catching signs early, we can increase the chances of a better outcome for our patients.

We don't know what causes most mouth

cancers. However, there are several factors that are likely to increase your risk. Up to 90% of all mouth cancers are linked to lifestyle factors.

This means that with a few small changes, you can help cut your chances of developing mouth cancer.

- **Smoking**
- **Alcohol**
- **Chewing and smokeless tobacco**
- **Diet**
- **Sunlight and sunbeds**

Regular visits to your dentist not only help you maintain good dental and oral health, it can be lifesaving if any potential oral cancer signs appear.
